

Exterior Maintenance:

The more effort put into the exterior maintenance of your OI Restroom trailer, the longer it will look better than your competitors and the longer it will last.

Wash – Wax – Polish

Washing your unit is not only good for its appearance, but also for the longevity of the finish. Be sure to spend a little extra time spraying the entire exterior completely to remove the dirt and road debris that could scratch the exterior surfaces.

For best results, choose a wax formulated for Gel Coated Fiberglass. These are normally found in the RV/Marine section. Pick a brand to your liking and follow the directions on the package. All fiberglass providers require waxing in their warranties.

Polish as needed.

Do not use abrasive or industrial cleaners as they can damage and/or remove the gel coat layer.

Storage:

When your trailer is stored outside, always set it with the front higher than the rear. This will keep any leftover liquids or any water entering the waste tank via the vent stack from getting into the gate valve and causing any damage in freezing temperatures. This will also help keep snow and ice from forming and/or building up on the roof of your trailer. It is recommended to perform periodic inspections of your trailer(s) during storage.
